

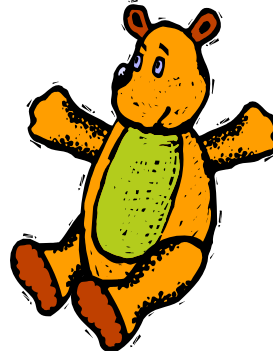


Key Stage One News
